Some CDC Resolutions of the past 25 years

1998 We, as the Central District Conference of General Conference Mennonite Church gathered at Bluffton College, June 18-20, 1998, **deplore and grieve the presence of handguns** in our society and the violence and death caused by the use of the handguns in our homes, schools and communities. Therefore, be it resolved that we call our society to join us in taking a bolder stand against this violence by supporting such actions as handgun legislation, teaching conflict mediation, praying and confronting the economical and racial injustices which lie at the root of this violence and in which we may knowingly or unknowingly participate."

2003 Affirm the Atlanta Mennonite Fellowship in their service to the people of Atlanta. (LGBTQ+ affirming congregation)

#### 2004 Resolution on USA & Iraq

2005 **Resolution on Military Recruitment**. (Organize counter-recruitment efforts in local schools)

#### 2012 Congregational Peace Pledge
